

SPECIAL MEETING

The Lexington City Council met in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, September 22, 2021, at 5:30 p.m., at City Hall, 604 Wheatley, Lexington, Texas.

Present was Mayor Allen Retzlaff, Councilpersons David Mason, Chris Billings Jessica Reda, and Elvis Lewis.

Mayor Allen Retzlaff brought the meeting to order and welcomed the guests.

2. Public hearing to consider adopting a proposed tax rate for tax year 2021. The proposed tax rate is 0.469500 per \$100 of value. The proposed rate would increase total taxes in the City of Lexington by 4%.

3. David Mason made the motion to adopt the 2021 tax rate of 0.469500 per \$100 of value. Elvis Lewis seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.

4. Elvis Lewis made the motion to contact Wrench-A-Part – Snyder's to sell/part-out the 2013 Dodge Charger. Jessica seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.
